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- **1. Objective**: Disinfestation of household flies by integrated approach of preventive and curative treatments

2. Method of Disinfestation:

2.1 Preventive Measures: Recommendation of proofing measures, proper sanitation and hygiene practices.

2.2 Curative Measures:

- 2.2.1 Placement of fly baits at numbered fly stations at outside entry points.
- 2.2.2 Placement of Giant fly traps, Fly ribbons as per requirement.
- 2.2.3 Residual pesticide spray at probable breeding places.
- 2.2.3 Pesticide spraying at entry points depending upon requirements.
- **2.3: Monitoring**: Count of trapped flies at Insect Lights traps on random baisi shall be maintained

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3. Pesticides and other materials to be used:

6. Do's & Don'ts

- 6.1.1 Thorough assessment of areas to recommend proofing measures.
- 6.1.2 Maintain proper spaces along wall to install rodent stations.
- 6.1.3 Remove all unwanted materials to prevent breeding of rodents inside premise.
- 6.1.4 Recommend proper hygiene and sanitation practices.

6. Do's & Don'ts

- 6.2 Don'ts
- 6.2.1 Don't eat, smoke and drink during treatment.
- 6.2.2 Don't apply glue traps at dusty places.
- 6.2.3 Don't apply any pesticides over rodent baits and glue traps.
