**2.1 Preventive Measures:** Recommendation of proofing measures for all entry points of lizards.

2.2.1 Placement of glue traps near light source at inside areas.

2.2.2 Application of water on adult lizards at evening time and and catch with glue traps.

**2.3: Monitoring:** Count of captured lizards shall be maintained

  - 6.1.2 Maintain proper spaces along wall to carry out treatments.
  - 6.1.3 Remove all unwanted materials to prevent breeding of lizards inside premise.

### 6. Do's & Don'ts

- 6.2 Don'ts
  - 6.2.1 Don't eat, smoke and drink during treatment.
  - 6.2.2 Don't apply glue traps at dusty places.
  - 6.2.3 Don't apply any pesticides over rodent baits and glue traps.
